Community meetings for Comprehensive Operational Analysis of Metropolitan Transit System Bus and Trolley services

The San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) is conducting a Comprehensive Operational Analysis (COA) of its bus and trolley services. The project is divided into two phases: the first phase will optimize the system to improve efficiencies to achieve a balanced operating budget. A second phase will seek to redevelop and optimize transit services to better reflect travel demand patterns and reduce trip times. The results of the COA will affect the majority of MTS bus and trolley services and will include schedule and routing changes. Adopted proposals from the COA will be implemented beginning in June 2005, with later phases occurring through 2006.

MTS is holding a series of community meetings to provide information on the project process and schedule, and to collect public comments on the first phase of proposed service changes. MTS passengers, area residents, business owners, and other interested individuals are encouraged to attend one of the following community meetings, held in different locations throughout the MTS service area:
